

## Lok Sabha passes two bills amid din

**NEW DELHI, JULY 26** -- / The Lok Sabha today passed the Factoring Amendment Bill and National Institute of Food Technology Bill without debate amid protest over various issues, including the Pegasus snooping controversy. Moving the Factoring Regulation (Amendment) Bill, 2020 for consideration and passage, Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman said the changes in the legislation are aimed at helping the MSME sector. The amendments to the factoring law are based on the recommendations of the U K Sinha Committee. She further the government has accepted the recommendations of the Standing Committee which had last year scrutinised the bill.

The bill was approved by the Lok Sabha by voice vote without any debate. "Increase in the availability of working capital may lead to growth in the business of the micro, small and medium enterprises sector and also boost employment in the country," according to the Statement of Objects and Reasons of the bill. The amendments are expected to help micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs) significantly by providing added avenues for getting credit facility, especially through Trade Receivables Discounting System. The Factoring Regulation Act, 2011 was enacted to provide

for regulating the assignment of receivables to factors, registration of factors carrying on factoring business and the rights and obligations of parties to the contract for assignment of receivables.

Factoring is a transaction where a business entity sells its receivables from a customer to a third party which is a factor for immediate realisation of funds either in part or in full. It may include invoice discounting, recourse factoring, non-recourse factoring, collections and reverse factoring. International factoring includes export factoring, import factoring, export invoice discounting and reverse factoring. The bill seeks to widen the scope of entities which can engage in factoring business.

The Factoring Regulation (Amendment) Bill, 2020, was introduced in the Lok Sabha on September 24, 2020, with a view to liberalise the restrictive provisions in the Act and at the same time ensure that a strong regulatory/oversight mechanism is put in place through the RBI. Soon thereafter, the Lok Sabha approved the National Institutes of Food Technology, Entrepreneurship and Management Bill, 2021. (PTI)

## SKM announces 'Mission UP, Uttarakhand', threatens to hold protests in Lucknow akin to Delhi stir

**LUCKNOW, JULY 26** -- / The Samyukt Kisan Morcha, spearheading the farmers' campaign against the Centre's three agricultural laws, today announced its "Mission UP and Uttarakhand", saying it will turn Lucknow into Delhi and hold a 'maha rally' in Muzaffarnagar. "The farmers' agitation will not end till the Government of India withdraws these three black laws.

We want to tell the government here (UP) as well to work properly otherwise our agitation is intensifying and Lucknow will also be turned into Delhi and all roads leading to the state capital from all sides will be sealed," Bhartiya Kisan Union (BKU) leader Rakesh Tikait told reporters here. But, he did not elaborate on when the planned agitation will begin in Lucknow. This mission will start with a 'maha rally' of farmers from Muzaffarnagar in Uttar Pradesh on September 5 and mahapanchayats will be held at all the divisional headquarters in the state with an aim to take the eight-month-old agitation to the village level, Tikait said.

He said, "The historic farmers' agitation for the repeal of three anti-farmer laws and demanding legal guarantee of the minimum support price has completed eight months. In these months, the movement, which became a symbol of self-respect and unity of the farmers, is now a movement to save democracy and save the country." In a statement, the Samyukt Kisan Morcha (SKM) said it has decided to start the next phase of the movement as Mission Uttar Pradesh and Uttarakhand to make it

more intensive and effective. The objective of this mission would be that like Punjab and Haryana, every village in UP and Uttarakhand will be involved in the movement, it said.

The SKM leaders, who addressed a joint press conference, demanded making all toll plazas free in UP and Uttarakhand, organising protests at commercial establishments of capitalists and boycotting the programs of the BJP and its allies. Tikait said, "Now, Lucknow will be turned into Delhi. Like in Delhi, where all roads are sealed by farmers from all sides, in Lucknow too farmers will surround the city from all sides. We will devise our strategy for this and make

preparations for it." He said a series of meetings, visits and rallies would be started all over UP to make this mission work. The SKM has divided the movement into four phases.

In the first phase, contact and coordination will be established with the organisations active in the movement in the states and in the second phase there will be division-wise farmers' convention and district-wise preparatory meeting. In the third phase, a "historic" mahapanchayat of farmers from across the country would be organised in Muzaffarnagar on September 5 and in the fourth phase, a mahapanchayat would be organised at all the divisional headquarters. The SKM has also decided that along with national issues, local issues of farmers will also be taken up in this mission. The farmer leaders addressing the press conference said the aim of the mission would also be to challenge the corporate power and "anti-farmer" BJP and its allies at every step, adding that it is the responsibility of the state and its people to save farming and farmers from the corporate houses and their political middlemen. ## DCW identifies 791 women widowed due to Covid, submits list to Delhi govt for rehabilitation

**NEW DELHI, JULY 26** -- / The Delhi Commission for Women (DCW) has identified 791 women who were widowed due to the COVID-19 pandemic, and it has submitted a report to the city government to ensure their rehabilitation.

The Commission has also conducted a social survey of all these women to help the government in the rehabilitation process. The social survey was conducted on the grassroots level by the DCW through its Mahila Panchayat network. The Delhi government has rolled out the "Mukhyamantri Covid-19 Pariwar Aarthik Sahayata Yojana" under which an ex-gratia of Rs 50,000 will be provided to those who have lost a family member to coronavirus. The

scheme also provides for an additional Rs 2,500 pension per month if the deceased was the sole breadwinner. The social survey conducted by the DCW will increase the access of the identified women to the benefits of this scheme. The Commission is still identifying other women who were widowed during Covid pandemic and will submit additional lists to the government, it added.

According to the survey report, 774 (97.85 per cent out of 791 women) have at least one child while 360 women have three to five children. It found that 30 women have over five children. From the list of identified 791 women, 734, which accounts for 92.79 per cent, are in the age bracket of 18-60 years, while the rest are senior citizens.

Nearly 191 women fall in the age group of 18-35, the survey found. Out of the 791 women, 721 are housewives, while the rest work as domestic workers, labourers, small

business owners and private and government employees. Nearly 28.57 per cent of the women have no source of income while almost 60 per cent women have a monthly income of less than Rs 15,000, it found. It was also found that 597 women had not been vaccinated till the date of survey. "The Commission strongly believes that it is very important to get these women vaccinated on priority. The Commission has recommended the government to issue an order to the district magistrates to get these women vaccinated," the DCW said.

The commission said the scheme by the Delhi Government will come in very useful for the rehabilitation of these women and the benefits must reach them. DCW Chief Swati Malviwal said, "We got our Mahila Panchayat teams to go door-to-door to identify women who got widowed and were able to identify 791 such women. (PTI)
